This associate pastor shall serve as the student and worship pastor and shall oversee the Junior High and High School Sunday school classes, weekly youth group meetings, and special events for the students as well as lead the praise team on Sunday morning.

### ANTICIPATED TIME COMMITMENTS

4. Oversee praise team and music specials on Sunday morning, which includes scheduling, developing new songs, weekly practices, and understanding the sound equipment.
5. Recruit and train worship team members.
6. Be part of the pastoral team that may include weddings, funerals, communion, pastoral counseling, pastoral care, and teaching/preaching.
7. Serve as needed for all-church events as a part of a team of both staff and volunteers.
8. Oversee other ministries at the discretion of the Senior Pastor.
